You must have software which permits you to receive and access Portable Document Format or "PDF" files, such as Adobe Acrobat Reader® version 7.0 or higher. You will also need access to a printer or the ability to download and save information in order to keep copies for your records. By consenting, you acknowledge that you meet the hardware and software requirements. If your Internet browser or Adobe Acrobat is updated to a higher version after you've given your consent, you may need to download the higher version in order to access and/or print the disclosures in the future.

You may request paper copies of disclosures at any time, free of charge, after consenting to receive electronic disclosures and submitting your online application(s), by contacting us using any of the methods provided below. You may also withdraw your consent at any time; however, that may result in the revocation of your ability to obtain future products and services from ACCU through electronic channels. To request and receive future products and services electronically, a new E-Sign consent would be required.
