- 1. NO PURCHASE OR OBLIGATION NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.
- 2. Non-Purchase Entries and Purchase Entries Have an Equal Chance of Winning.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY: America's Christian Credit Union (ACCU) United Pentecostal Church International (UPCI) Summit Sweepstakes ("Sweepstakes") is open to those who are attending UPCI Summit, who are legal residents of the United States, and at least 18 years of age as of October 1, 2024. Void where prohibited. ACCU associates, officers, directors, volunteers, employees, representatives, agents, and their immediate families are not eligible to participate; individuals living in the same households of each of these individuals, whether related or not, are not eligible to enter or win. The potential winner will be notified by text message on October 5 at 5:00 p.m. PST. Standard messaging and data rates may apply. Noncompliance with these Official Rules will result in the potential winner's disqualification and, at ACCU's discretion the prize may be awarded to a potential alternate winner.
